Topping-out ceremony of SELFRAG 35'000 tons p.a. slag treatment plant in Full-Reuenthal. State of the art technology. Major positive environmental impacts.

Full-Reuenthal, June 8th, 2022. SELFRAG celebrated today the topping-out ceremony of its Centro Uno 35'000 tons p.a. slag treatment plant in Full-Reuenthal.

State of the art technology

Construction of this state-of-the art slag treatment plant started the beginning of January 2022 and is targeted to be completed by the end of 2022. Production will start as of the beginning of 2023. The plant will treat 35'000 of slag (IBA – incinerated bottom ash) per year from the incinerators Renergia, Turgi and Buchs.

Best in class 50% recovery

SELFRAG's unique technology and process allow the unprecedented recovery of at least 50% of the slag treated. The volume to be landfilled will so be reduced by 50% and at the same time valuable metals and minerals will be recovered and reintroduced into the economic cycle.

Strong environmental impact: over 15'000 tons of CO2 saved per year

The plant will recover approximately 720 kilos of CO_2 per ton of slag treated. SELFRAG is currently qualifying the process and the plant for the issuance of approximately 15'000 tons of CO_2 credits p.a. in the voluntary CO_2 market. The qualification is done with the support of South Pole the leading company in this field.

Broad base of academic, technical, and financial partners

The project is being realized with a broad base of reputable academic, technical, and financial partners.

Strong local and cantonal support

The project has a broad-based support by the community of Full-Reuenthal as well as by the Authorities of the Canton of Aargau. The environmental impact study and all related permitting requirements were dealt with in a professional, transparent, and open manner.
